Contractual arrangements

- NERC-CEH acts as the Executing Agency, UNEP acts as the GEF Implementing Agency.
- UNEP signs a contract with CEH for the completion of the project.
- CEH signs subcontracts with partners who are being provided funding from the project.
- All project partners funded and not funded, sign a 'Letter of commitment and co-financing'.



Reporting requirements

- Reporting line : Project Partners → CEH → UNEP → GEF
- Reporting to be done quarterly
- Types of reports:
- a) Progress report (on the tasks completed) quarterly
- b) Financial report on expenditures relating to the project quarterly
- c) Financial report on co-financing relating to the project once a year
- d) Final report after the project's completion
- Audit reports prepared by certified public accountants, after the first 2 years, and thereafter at the end of the project
- All reports to be completed in English and financial reports expressed in USD



Financing

- Periodic payments from UNEP to CEH made on submission of the periodic reports
- CEH makes payments to project partners on successful delivery of the project outputs
- GEF/UNEP provides funding for the project but partners also need to provide co-financing (cash and/or in-kind) in the ratio of 1:6
