- Responsive to change (adaptive management)




























Towards INMS – Overall Governance



Towards INMS – Overall Project Management



General Assembly

- Meet annually to review all aspects of the project (progress, overall workplan & budget, communication strategy)
- Reviews reports etc to be submitted by the project to the IA
- Reviews project overall workplan/budget for execution by PCU
- All CF partners assist in providing guidance on project execution
- Observers present at meetings if requested
- Chair elected at, and for, the GA meeting
- PCU acts as secretariat











Project Management Board

- Discussion forum for addressing operational details of GA reviewed annual work plan
- Endorses reports from PCU to GA
- Composed of: IA, EA, PCU, Component leads/co-leads, advisors











PCU

- Responsible for day-to-day management of the project
- Responsible for preparing/supervising all reports
- Responsible for preparing ToRs (etc.) for procurement of services via the EA
- Responsible for all M&E activities including recording/reporting of achievements
- Responsible for managing budgets within parameters approved by the Management Board
- Responsible for delivering the GA reviewed work plan
